OXFORD™



The original version of the Oxford™ chair was designed for the professors at St. Catherine's College in Oxford. The chair's extra tall back served as a symbol of prestige and created a space of its own. The "professor's chair" later evolved into the Oxford series. In spite of initial protests and uproar over the commission of a foreign modernist, Arne Jacobsen received an honorary doctorate from Oxford, upon completion of the project. This ground breaking example of total design is, today, considered Arne Jacobsen's most outstanding work.



ARNE JACOBSEN 1902-1971

The cooperation between Arne Jacobsen and Fritz Hansen dates back to 1934. But it was in 1952 the break-through came with the Ant™. It was succeeded by the Series 7™ in 1955. This propelled his and Fritz Hansen's names into furniture history. Arne Jacobsen was very productive both as an architect and as a designer. At the end of the 50s Arne Jacobsen designed the Royal Hotel in Copenhagen, and for that project the Egg™, the Swan™, the Swan™ sofa and Series 3300™. Arne Jacobsen was and is an admired and outstanding designer. While the significance of Arne Jacobsen's buildings was less appreciated, his furniture and other design work have become national and international heritage.



DESIGN

DESCRIPTION

Series of chairs, armchairs and loungechairs designed by Arne Jacobsen, manufactured by Fritz Hansen.

The shell is moulded wood covered with polyurethane foam and upholstered with fabric or leather. The armrest and bases (4 or 5-star) is moulded satin-polished aluminium.

All chairs are available with low, medium high or high back; double castors with aluminium caps or black-grey synthetic toes; with fixed seat height or height adjustment incl. tilt mechanism.

The accessories include mirror chromed base and arms (not the Lounge version), leather padded arms, automatic return mechanism, glides, hard or soft castors with or without brake action.

UPHOLSTERY

The upholstery is available in the Kvadrat fabrics Fame, Hallingdal, Divina, Divina Melange, Tonus, Topas, Steelcut, Bespoke, Stripe, Stripes and Comfort from Gabriel. The leather includes Basic, Soft, Natural, White, Optical white, and Elegance.

ENVIRONMENT & TESTS

For environmental reasons all parts of Oxford can be dismantled. The plastic material can be granulated and recycled and the aluminium can be melted and recycled. The Oxford chairs have been GS certified (Geprüfte Sicherheit) by LGA in Nuremberg in Germany. The chair meets EN 13761 Office Furniture - Visitors chair, EN1728 for strength and durability, level 4 according to DS/INF 130; and EN 1022 and EN 1335 for stability.

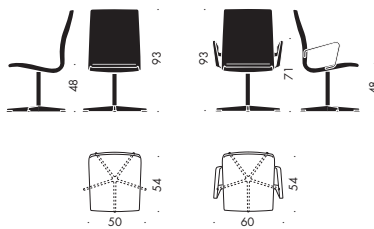
WARRANTY
